[EXTERNAL] WHITEWATER BACKGROUND

In early April , Macy Brooks working with the Springdale Chamber purchased an airline ticket and flew Mr Scott Shipley, President and Founder of S2O to Springdale for a brief tour and meeting. Macy had suggested consideration of a Riverwalk and Whitewater park for downtown? Members of Water and Sewer , the Mayor and Civic and Business leaders met at the Tyson technology center downtown and Mr Shipley presented a brief presentation about stream restoration and whitewater pumped parks. It's his passion and business. S2O designed the 2012 London Olympics and the National Whitewater center in Charolette, NC. They build parks all around the world and Macy wanted the Best for Springdale. At that meeting Mr Shipley invited Springdale officials to come tour the Charolette facility at an event they were hosting for prospective customers at the end of April. Macy attended accompanied by her father Joe G Brooks.

Based on this Springdale Planning and Engineering shared data with S2O and a follow up meeting was scheduled on 6-7 after (S2O) returned from a project in Australia.

Numerous projects are currently underway around the world with several in the US.

A brief photo album was prepared based on the Charolette trip. A very impressive facility attended by over 1.1 million people last yr that is financially strong and sustainable on its own.

With Springdales history and leadership with water and the boom in outdoor tourism ; it is Macy's and manys opinion that Springdale is the perfect spot for a Whitewater activity park.

The initial evaluation was a look at a Riverwalk through town and then shifted west down Spring Creek to the Lake Springdale area.

After the discovery of a Conservation easement at Rabbitfoot lodge, S2O has been asked to preliminarily look at what would be involved to create a Wow in that area around an Urban Forest setting.
